

John 19:28-42

“It is finished!”

John wants us to see that Jesus' death wasn't an accident: it was all part of God's plan that was talked about all through the Old Testament! (*Draw lines to link the verses from John 19 to the Old Testament verses they remind us about.*)

John 19:28-29

Jesus said, “I am thirsty.” A jar of wine vinegar was there...

Zechariah 12:10

They will look on me, the one they pierced...

John 19:36

These things happened so that the Scripture would be fulfilled: “Not one of his bones will be broken.”

Psalms 69:21

They put gall in my food and gave me vinegar for my thirst.

John 19:37

And again another Scripture says, “They will look on him who they have pierced.”

Exodus 12:46


The Passover lamb must be eaten inside the house; take none of the meat outside the house. Do not break any of the bones.

All of this means that we know Jesus didn't just die because the Jewish leaders hated Him, or because the Roman governor was scared of Him. Jesus died **on purpose!**
