
1 Peter 1:13-2:3 A Distinctive Lifestyle

Salvation

God is *very* different from people: we're so often mean and we often lie to get what we want. God is *always* pure and good and right. And He wants us to be like that too!

Sanctification

We deserve to be sent away from God forever because of all the wrong things we do, but God saves us from that punishment.

Holy

God's Holy Spirit changes us bit by bit to become more like Him!

God kindly gives us Jesus to be our **Saviour** and also our **King.** And He tells us in 1 Peter 1:13-2:3 to **remember** how Jesus saved us, and to **follow** Jesus as our King.
