Peter says in verse 8 that the devil is like a lion prowling round waiting to eat us—which might sound scary! But he also tells us *not* to be scared, because Jesus is much more powerful. So instead of running away, Peter tells us to stand firm (verses 9 and 10) even when it's hard.

Peter warns us that it's hard following Jesus, because other people don't understand why we live like this, and because the devil tries to stop us following Jesus. But he also reminds us that Jesus is with us, helping us to keep going! (This is a great verse to remember! Can you colour it **and** memorise it too?)
